New Field: Bandé Village

The village of Bandé has been a new opportunity for outreach. The MEDiC-Togo team has continued their visits to the village. The villagers are excited, and have begun to build a shelter for a church. We are grateful their hearts are open to hearing the Good News.



During one visit, Pastor Karim was given a glass of water. He noticed the water had the odor of urine and inquired. The chief explained that the villagers ob-



tain their water from a stream about 3 miles away where herdsmen also bring their cattle. The villagers try

to dig near the riverbed to obtain clean water as best they can. People from several other surrounding areas also obtain their water here.



Pastor Karim asked why they had not tried to dig a well in the village. The villagers showed him their attempt at digging the well. The had dug about 6 meters until they hit rock, and by hand are unable to proceed.

As you take a drink of your water today, pray for this village and for us to have wisdom in how to best help the people of Bandé.
