#### Film Projection and New Field

We provided a generator, and God provided a film projector for the "Jesus" film projection in the villages at the North of Togo. Tchalosso is a village about



30 km from our church at Sabaringadé. There is no school or church in this village. Children cross a river to go to school so in the rainy season they can not attend school. It is their first time to hear

about Jesus through the projection. We pray for continued open opportunities to gather people and share the Gospel in this village. We also pray to have another projector and generator for use in the South and the Center of Togo.

## Land provided

We thank God for his provision. The land at Anié holds a temporary structure built for the church. By the grace of God, we purchased the land for the church. Now the church can move ahead with plans for a permanent structure. Anié is at the center of Togo. The second church, in the same area, is the church of Ibéfo village, 25 km from Anié.



### **Building progress**

We continue to be amazed and excited about the progress at each of the churches.

At Labide, the walls have been plastered, the floor of the church has been cemented, and we finished building the platform. Thank you for your help.



At **Sabaringadé** and **Doussidé** we pray to buy cement for the floor to plaster the walls. For the two building we need 100 packages of cement (\$10 for one package). Continue to pray with us for God's provision to finish these two buildings.

At **Sewouvé**, in the South, more cement is needed as the making of cement bricks has begun. This is an exciting step as we hope to help build the walls during our upcoming trip to Togo.

At **Botcholéo** funds are needed for the land purchase. The chief has granted permission to purchase 8 squares of land at a discount price of \$800 for all. This is a tremendous discount and we praise God.

At **Tchaourodé**, we thank God for finishing the small structure for the church. This is the newest church plant.

We continue to praise God for the many church members who have come out to work on each of the church buildings.

Donga a 15 years old girl and member of Sabaringadé church, was orphaned a year ago along with her brother Kpakai and younger sister. One day she was climbing a tree, to obtain small seeds to sell in the market, when the whole tree crashed to the ground.



Donga fell from tree and broke her upper leg. We praise God that He spared her life. We thank God for the funds for the needed surgery to twist her bones back into place. Today she is recovering at home in the village. We pray she will quickly be able to walk and continue her schooling. Please keep her in your prayers, along with her brother and sister, as the church takes care of these orphaned teens.

Travel Note: We praise God for using so many people to encourage us in the ministry. We are planning for a short term trip to Togo this August. We are making lists of items to take such as a portable projectors, t-shirts, and other ministry items. We will be planning celebrations at each of the new churches, and organizing seminars for the men and women. We also plan tgtby6ho hold some fun children's ministry.
